Topics Covered

Fire legislation, fire and its differing classes, fire spread within a building, firefighting procedures, causes of fires and their prevention, evacuation assembly point and fire drills, fire alarms, role of the Fire Marshall, routine fire safety inspections and maintaining a fire log, risk assessment awareness, extinguisher recognition and use (theory).

- Understand the use of fire doors and other basic fire prevention measures
- Describe what to do in the event of a fire including evacuations and assembly points.
- Role and responsibilities of fire marshal.
