



## HABC Level 2 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work

### Who needs this Qualification?

Anyone identified by their employer as being suitable to take on the role as emergency first aider in their workplace as required by the First Aid at works regulations 1981.

It can be undertaken as:

- Initial training
- Three-yearly requalification

### Topics Covered

Managing Incidents, Basic Life Support, Examination of a Casualty, Unconsciousness, Control of Bleeding, Burns and Scalds, Regulations, First Aid Kits, Recording and Reporting.

### Learning outcomes

- Understand the role and responsibilities of a first aider.
- Be able to assess an incident.
- Be able to manage an unresponsive casualty who is breathing normally.
- Be able to manage an unresponsive casualty who is not breathing normally.
- Know how to recognize and assist a casualty who is choking.
- Be able to manage a casualty with external bleeding.
- Be able to manage a casualty who is in shock.
- Be able to manage a casualty with a minor injury.

### Qualification

On successful completion of this course, you will receive an **emergency first aid at work certificate** which is valid for **three years**.

Be 16 years of age prior to certification.
